

Vaccination of cats

8 weeks old	Combination-vaccine
12 weeks old	Second Combination-vaccine and Rabies
9 months later	Combination-vaccine and Rabies
Annually	Combination-vaccine

After the second Rabies vaccination, Rabies is administered every three years. **By law all cats in South Africa have to be vaccinated against Rabies.**

The combination-vaccines of cats

Panleucopaenia

A similar disease to "cat flu" in dogs. Although not common these days it is still deadly.

Rhinotracheitis

This herpesvirus causes eye and upper respiratory infection.

Calicivirus

Causes upper respiratory and joint infection.

Chlamydiosis

Causes pneumonia in cats, but could also infect humans.

The virus of **Feline leukaemia** is available for vaccination. This disease is very important in catteries.

Please ensure that your cat is vaccinated at least 21 days prior to entering checking into the cattery.
